The Population Policy Consultation Document gave us some surprises. It showed the urgency of the problem. - (2) To have proper control, there can be one or more unmoderated forums for anybody to express his opinion. Some of the useful discussions can then be promoted to the moderated forum.
- (3) Note the use of the term 'multi-way' discussions. Many parties can participate in the discussion on the worthwhile topics or suggestions within minutes. This is much better than collecting tons of comments and then tries to organize and deal with them at the end of the consultation period."
