Comments:

For local manpower, I do not think massive importation of labour is a good idea for Hong Kong at this moment. Firstly, it may spark an outcry in the society because lots of people are discontent since they afraid that importation of labour would affect their job opportunity and lower their salary. Also, if there is a massive importation of labour, the workers are usually came from Mainland China which means that lots of Mainlanders will live and work in Hong Kong at that time, the dispute between Mainlanders and Hong Kong people will be worsen. Secondly, I believe that some of the shortage of labour in some industries is due to the relatively low level of income such as the industry of elderly home and lack of promotion. If Hong Kong government and employers can work together to provide more training programme and increase the average salary of the industry, the shortage of labour will be alleviated.

For family fertility, I do not agree with a direct subsidy for assisted reproductive technology. I think that if a couple cannot have a baby through reproduction, they can consider about adoption because if the couple is really eager to have a baby, then they should first consider about those children who are abandoned by their parents but if they insisted to have assisted reproduction, then they should paid by their own. Also, assistive reproductive technology is still quite costly nowadays, a direct subsidy will increase the government's financial burden heavily.

For active ageing, I think the government can put more resources to the community centre so that they can organize more interest class and provide additional service to the senior citizens. For example, they can organize a computer class which is taught by elderly. Some elderly may have skills but the society does not provide them with enough chance to use them, thus I suggest that the government can put more resources to the community centre so that they can organize more activities for the senior citizens. As a result, instead of staying at home to do nothing, elderly can spend on time on community centre to keep in touch with their friend, technology or even the society so that they will not get behind and be forgotten by the society.
