There are many different aspects that we should concern on about the population policy. And I would like to focus on the aspect about local human resources. Local human resources are necessities to our local market. It is more urgent to have more local people work for ourselves.

In order to urge female homemaker and early retiree to work, policies such as providing work opportunities or giving subsidies +to their younger generation have to be implemented. Actually, if female are homemakers, that already shows they have plenty amount of money to maintain their living and do not need to work for surviving. If people can retire earlier than the stated age, that means they have already earned enough savings for their living, they do not need to find jobs urgently. Both these two kinds of people do not need money urgently, if they need to find jobs difficultly or do not have any extra benefit; they would not have any intension to enter the market again. In addition, they do not need benefits for themselves necessarily. Instead of providing help to them, provide extra help for their younger generation will be more favourable to them.
