It is necessary to maintain a high quality work force attracting the best talents from all over the world to build up a wealthier Hong Kong, hoping they can create more new industries and new economic locomotives in Hong Kong.

It is necessary to provide software to attract talents:

- a) provide good quality, available and affordable international school education for expatriates children
- b) better living quality, increase land supply using the land in NENT and NWNT and build larger homes for the middle class.
- c) cleaner air
- d) freedom to express our views and preserve press freedom
