When I worked with HKU two years ago, they have a policy that staff can work for half-time or on fractional basis. And those staff would receive half of the salary or on per rata.

I think this is a very good idea and policy to encourage more women to give birth, while still have the ability to earn money and to get in touch with the working environment.

I believe HKG could started to promote this within government departments. And that especially easy for contract staff as contract staff do not have MPF offered by Gov or any retirement benefit.
